**Footnotes**

CORSA DI CAVALLI three deep early, prompted the pace outside the runner-up, stalked that one on the turn, bid again in midstretch under some left handed urging, gained a short lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. TALE BE TOLD bobbled then steadied at the start, angled in and chased inside, came out around the fallen rider early on the turn, angled back in and rallied along the rail in the stretch. CAST A DOUBT had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back in midstretch then between foes in deep stretch and held third. J MAN between horses early, chased just off the rail or outside a rival, came out in the stretch and finished with interest four wide on the line. HE'S A BANDIT stalked outside, went four wide into the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. OBSERVANCE pulled between horses stalking the pace, bumped with GOOD MOJO into the turn and was crowded midway on the turn by that one after the rider came off and weakened some in the stretch. PETAK MOUNTAIN settled and angled in a bit off the rail on the backstretch, found the fence midway on the turn and lacked the needed rally. TEASING

BERNIE stalked between horses then three deep into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. GOOD MOJO stalked the pace inside, appeared to make contact with the rail then bumped with a rival into the turn and unseated the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident into the far turn before ruling no other runners were responsible for the trouble.
