**Footnotes**

CINCO DE MARIO stalked between horses then outside, came four wide into the stretch, angled inward in upper stretch, rallied under some urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. WILDCAT CANDY broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then split horses leaving the backstretch, came out four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and just got the place. BIG MACHER stalked outside then bid alongside the leader to gain the advantage on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and again in the drive, drifted in alongside the winner in deep stretch and was edged late for the place. SOUL CRUSHER hesitated to be away behind the field, settled off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. GRANT between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail then inside, waited off heels into the turn and again leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, angled in and lacked the needed late kick. MILK MAN RAY squeezed early, chased between horses or just off the rail, steadied off heels into the turn, came out and steadied again four wide nearing the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TROUBLE X TWO settled outside a rival or three deep, came out on the turn, steadied in tight five wide into the stretch and did not rally. DARK TIMBERS chased outside, went four wide on the turn and six wide into the stretch and lacked a response. SUPERSONIC HEAT saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and did not rally. IN EXCESSIVENESS stalked off the rail, was in tight between horses into the turn, continued between foes leaving the turn and weakened. SHERIFF HUTTON stalked off the inside, angled in on the turn and also weakened. WHEELER GORGE sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, angled in and dueled briefly on the turn, dropped back, drifted out into the stretch and gave way.
