BAJAN had good early speed and angled in, dueled then stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch, re-bid alongside the runner-up into the turn, battled alongside that one under urging through a stiff drive and gamely prevailed. SOUTHERN SUNSHINE dueled outside the winner then inched away midway on the backstretch, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the turn and through a long drive and went gamely to the wire. FASCINATING stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, continued off the inside in the stretch and went on willingly to best the rest. MISS LAFAYETTE saved ground chasing the pace, came out between foes into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MISS MACHIAVELLI three deep early, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. APPEARANCE pulled her way between horses to chase on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out leaving the bend and into the stretch and did not rally. ARETHUSA hopped a bit at the start, chased three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. VIOLATE was in a good position stalking the pace inside to the stretch and weakened.
