Footnotes

REGGAE QUEEN floated out into the first turn, chased three deep, bid three across the course on the second turn, led outside the pacesetter into the stretch, inched away and held under urging. ANGEL SONG saved ground unhurried early, split horses with a move forward leaving the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. SATIN CAT pulled a bit early, saved ground, moved up into the second turn, came out on that bend and four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. CASA'S KIDS pulled between horses and chased the leaders to the second turn, squeezed through between foes leaving that bend, split rivals with a bid in midstretch and missed the show. MISS TERASITA drifted out on the lead into the first turn, set a pressured pace along the inside but weakened in the stretch. CANONIZE (IRE) stalked the pace three deep on the first turn and backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. TOOTS squeezed a bit between foes at the start, saved ground stalking the pace and weakened in the stretch. ST. GALLEN stalked the early pace off the rail, bid outside a rival and dueled on the backstretch and most of the second turn, dropped back between foes leaving the bend and had little left. SEAFARING (GB) off a bit slowly, settled off the rail, angled in for the second turn and did not menace.
