Footnotes

FIRST TITANIUM angled in and had good early speed outside a rival, inched away on the first turn, set the pace inside, kicked clear in the stretch and just held under urging. KACHAMANDI (CHI) saved ground in midpack, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and closed willingly. MOST LIKELY (ARG) stalked the pace a bit off the rail, came out some leaving the second turn to loom a threat but was outfinished and just held third. MORE MODERN chased outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch, could not summon the needed late kick but just missed third. ALL THE GEARS a bit crowded early, pulled his way along off the rail early, chased outside on the backstretch and four wide into the second turn, went three deep leaving that bend and also just missed the show. BLACK SILK (GB) saved ground off the pace, continued inside throughout and lacked the needed rally. SPYCAT was in a bit tight early, pulled his way along off the rail, went outside a rival into and on the second turn, came out and was not a threat. RESOLVE sped to the early lead, stalked the winner along the inside, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened.
