T. G.'S BABE went up inside to prompt the pace, took a short lead along the rail on the turn, inched away nearing the stretch and won clear under steady handling. DAME FAME forced the pace outside on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, battled three deep on the bend, was no match for the winner in the stretch but clearly second best. SUSPICIOUS TOWN allowed to settle outside on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. B R LADY chased outside a rival then between foes, continued inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FAVORITE MISS had good early speed off the rail then duelled between horses, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. B. V. EXPRESS off a bit slowly, was sent along inside, came out into the stretch and was outrun. COURAGEOUS CICI forced the pace three deep between foes, dropped back and angled in on the turn and gave way.
