DREAM'S (CHI) stalked outside a rival, bid between horses leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued inside leaving that turn and in the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. GRECIAN (ARG) pulled her way to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, lugged out leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, drifted to the middle of the track in the stretch, was angled back in some then lugged out again late but went willingly to the wire. TOUPIE (GB) pulled her way along inside to chase the pace, came out a bit on the second turn, split rivals into the stretch and held third. CONVEYOR'S ANGEL pulled outside a rival stalking the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. BEAUTYANDTHEBEAST (GB) broke in the air and slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and finished well. QUEMAR (NZ) stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep into and on the second turn, was fanned four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. GRAT angled in and saved ground after a bit of a slow start, came out into the stretch and did not rally. LADY BERTRANDO pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened.
