GALLETA MONSTRUO had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, inched away under urging in the stretch and held sway. DOMONATION stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and continued willingly but could not catch the winner. REMUS a bit slow to begin, saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and was edged for the place. BRADY BLUE EYES stalked early then went up outside the winner to press the pace on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the final furlong. SUMMERS AT DELMAR bobbled a bit a step out of the gate, stalked the pace outside a rival then three deep on the turn, angled in slightly into the stretch and weakened. MAJESTIC VINTAGE close up stalking the pace outside a rival, fell back between horses on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
