Footnotes

RUN'N ON RESIDUALS sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside on a clear lead, opened up under urging in the stretch and just lasted. MIDNIGHT RAVEN a bit slow to begin and crowded some, settled between horses then inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and finished with a rush late to just miss. BUDS PAL stalked inside then a bit off the rail, was between horses in midstretch and held third. GOLD RANGER sent between horses then stalked outside or between foes, angled in on the turn, found the rail in the stretch then came out and split foes on the wire. SPARKLE JOEL three deep early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came out some in the stretch and lacked a response in the drive. VALEN angled in and saved ground chasing the pace throughout and could not offer the necessary response. CLOCKER MOMENT broke a bit slowly, settled off the inside, angled in some on the turn and improved position but was not a threat. SUPERSONIC HEAT off a bit slowly and squeezed some, steadied early, settled outside a rival, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. SUPER J. D. between horses then five wide early, stalked three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn and weakened. WAR FACE chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, weakened and was eased up in the final furlong. BITETHEBULITSUPER bobbed at the start, chased outside then five wide, continued four wide on the turn and into the stretch and had little left in the lane. FINEGAN AGAIN broke out onto foes then steadied in the early going, saved ground off the pace, gave way and was eased in the stretch. Complete Place Pick All winning numbers were 1/3-4/6-6/9/11/12-1/7-2/9-4/5-4/9-2/3/5-2/14-1/3/9.
