COOKIN VICKIE set fast fractions, led to the far turn while racing slightly off the rail, was caught and passed into the stretch but battled back gamely along the rail to inch clear from PENINSULA GIRL. The latter was unhurried for a half, ranged up three wide on the far turn, took a short lead into the stretch but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. SHIFTY HUSSEY chased the winner to the far turn but lacked the necessary late response. SPEAKING OF TIME was allowed to settle, advanced on the second turn and was closing on SHIFTY HUSSEY late. UPTICK CHICK lagged to the far turn and could only finish evenly. ST. EULALIA bobbled at the start, rated midpack to the far turn but came up empty in the drive. TOOTIE COOK was through early.
