RIBOLETTA (BRZ) stalked the early pace off the rail, bid outside the leader on the backstretch, dueled alongside that one, took a short lead nearing the quarter pole, inched away in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging. BORDELAISE (ARG) chased off the rail early then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, advanced outside leaving that turn, loomed a threat four wide into the stretch, could not catch the winner but gamely took the place. GOURMET GIRL sped to the early lead, set the pace toward the inside, dueled inside the winner on the backstretch and second turn, fought back when headed, could not match that one in the lane and lost second late. SPEAKING OF TIME saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. EXCELLENT MEETING squeezed a bit in the early strides, settled a bit off the rail, moved up boldly outside on the second turn and five wide into the stretch but could not sustain the bid in the drive. LOVELLON (ARG) came off the inside into the first turn, settled off the rail, angled in some for the second turn and was outrun.
