STAGE PLAYER pulled his way between horses then stalked off the rail on the first turn, tugged the jockey alongside the runner-up to force the pace on the backstretch and second turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch and proved best under a couple left handed cracks of the whip and good handling. GOLDEN ARROW sped to the early lead inside, set a pressured pace along the rail, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch but could not match the winner late. THE TIN MAN angled in nearing the first turn and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and gained the show late. FATHER THAMES (GB) saved ground stalking the pace, came out in upper stretch and was edged late for third. ANZIYAN ROYALTY three deep early, stalked outside a rival to the stretch and lacked the needed response. GRAFTON settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and did not rally.
