Footnotes

KARN stalked the pace off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, took a short lead four wide in midstretch, inched away under urging and held gamely. STRATAGEM settled a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and finished willingly but could not get by. SPECTACULAR BAY close up stalking the pace outside a rival or off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn and three deep between horses in midstretch and held third. TALEGA CREEK angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and just missed the show. CHANT FOR GOLD took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened. RAISE A TUNE (IRE) stalked inside, bid along the rail in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. STARSTONE hesitated then broke in the air to be off behind the field, trailed just off the inside then along the rail and was outrun.
