FINAL JOURNEY broke outward and slightly in the air, settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid three deep under left handed urging in midstretch, gained a short lead and inched away. CRAZY WAGER a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came out on the turn and into the stretch, lugged inward in midstretch but gained the place. RENTED COP bumped at the start, stalked outside a rival then bid three deep on the backstretch, dueled outside a rival on the turn, put a head in front into the stretch, fought back between horses in midstretch and held third. PHILLY SLEW dropped back after an alert beginning and being bumped at the break, settled outside a rival, drifted in a bit in midstretch, came out and did not rally. VELIKAYA pulled a bit early and stalked inside, bid along the rail, dueled inside on a short advantage, fought back in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. DEL MAR EXPRESS sent between horses to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled between horses, dropped back and angled in on the turn and gave way. COMIC THUNDER bumped at the start, settled off the rail chasing the pace, dropped back on the turn and in the stretch and also gave way.
