CITIZENS BRIGADE stalked off the rail, bid three deep between horses on the turn to put a head in front, fought back just off the rail then inside in the

stretch, inched away under urging and held sway. BONKERSFORBINKERS close up stalking the pace outside, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch, continued to battle outside the winner in the drive, could not quite match that one late but held second. DE BRIEF ME chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and picked up the show. GREAT RAID angled in and chased between foes then outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HEYWATCHULOOKINGAT settled off the pace and angled in, rode the rail on the turn, continued along the fence in the stretch and improved position. CLASS DISMISSED a bit slow into stride, went up inside to chase the pace, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, was between foes past midstretch and could not offer the necessary response. OUTSIDE SHOT settled between horses then off the rail, continued outside leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and did not rally. GOOD NEWSMAN broke outward and a bit slowly and awkwardly, settled outside then angled in alongside a rival, continued just off the inside on the turn, swung out into the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch, split rivals, bumped with a foe and steadied a sixteenth out and could not offer the necessary response. YES GEORGE went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn, dropped back into the stretch, came off the rail, was bumped and steadied between horses a sixteenth out and weakened. LITTLEBAYCORVETTE squeezed a bit at the start, went up between horses then dueled outside a rival, battled between foes on the turn, was in a bit tight while dropping back in upper stretch and also weakened. JUST BEAT IT broke in, had speed between horses then stalked outside or off the rail, dropped back on the turn, was between foes again leaving the turn and gave way.
