Footnotes

DAYLIGHT STORM forced then stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the turn, bid alongside the leader nearing the stretch, took the lead, inched away under urging in deep stretch and proved best. STREAKIN' MOHICAN dueled three deep then outside a rival, inched away a bit off the rail on the turn, fought back inside the winner in the stretch, drifted in some and was second best. MAYBE YES a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and gained the show late. UKANDOIT dueled between horses then inside, fell back a bit a half mile out, stalked outside a rival leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for third. FIRE IN THE WIND had good early speed and dueled between foes, continued inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch. KOOLNQUICK broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, chased outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. FARMER GILES (IRE) allowed to settle off the pace away from the inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
