PERFECT VINTAGE sped to the early lead, angled in and set all the pace along the inside and held gamely under some left handed urging. FREQUENT FAME chased inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in the drive and edged a foe for the place. LAZERED chased off the rail or outside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch and just missed second. CHURCH AVENUE stalked outside a rival, was between horses in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. YODELADY O saved ground stalking the winner, continued inside in the stretch and also weakened in the final furlong. TORREY CLIFFS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. SPANISH ICE stalked outside or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
