Footnotes

DYNAMIC RANGE chased outside a rival then pulled toward the inside into the clubhouse turn, continued inside on the backstretch and outside a rival on the final turn, came out into the stretch, bid three deep, gained the advantage past midstretch, drifted in some and proved best under good handling. HOG'S HOLLOW settled outside a rival, went three deep on the last turn, swung five wide into the stretch and gained the place outside a pair of foes on the line. DUCANE angled in and chased outside a rival then inside, came out leaving the final turn and into the stretch, took a short lead between horses in midstretch and just held third. RACKETEER saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the final turn and into the stretch, was in a bit tight in upper stretch, got through along the fence in midstretch and just missed the show. TRIPITAKA (GB) took the early lead three deep, angled in and set the pace outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence in the stretch the first time, fought back in the drive until past midstretch and weakened late. TEAFATILLER stalked inside then a bit off the rail, drifted out leaving the final turn and weakened. SARTORIAL between horses early, fell back some and chased just off the rail then outside, went three deep on the final turn, dropped back leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch.
