CHINESE PRAISE settled off the rail, angled in some leaving the backstretch, moved up inside then came out on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied under a left handed crack of the whip and a strong hand ride to gain the lead inside the sixteenth pole and won clear. LOS BOMBEROS sent to the early lead, set the pace on a clear advantage off the rail, drifted out some in the stretch, was not a match for the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. DEVOUR between horses early, chased off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch, was a bit crowded in upper stretch, angled inward past midstretch and was edged for the place. GIUSEPPE G chased the leader outside a rival, angled to the inside on the turn and lacked the needed rally but bested the others. FUELED BY KAFFINE dropped back off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and improved position. DA MARSHALL stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and into the turn, continued three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. UNBRIDLED SCORE saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and also weakened. STU'S GONE WILD was in a good position stalking the pace a bit off the rail then between foes leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
