SEÑOR RAIN had speed between horses early, dueled three deep then outside a rival, inched away leaving the turn, found the rail in the stretch and won clear under left handed urging. QUALITY ELUSION chased between horses then three deep on the turn, angled in outside a rival into the stretch, drifted in and was second best. DANGER RANGER stalked five wide on the backstretch and outside on the turn, came into the stretch three deep, also drifted in and bested the rest. SABE stalked between horses then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FEAR THE BEARD chased off the rail then angled in, steadied off heels into the turn, found the rail, was in tight again into the stretch, came out and improved position. ENUFF BULL a step slow to begin, chased inside, was in tight in upper stretch, split rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. YANKEE DAN dueled between horses then stalked on the turn, was in tight off heels into the stretch and weakened. TRAWEEK allowed to settle outside then alongside a rival, steadied sharply off heels into the turn, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. LANGFURS LIGHTNING stalked the pace between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, split rivals into the stretch and weakened. NAVY SEAL SIX stalked four wide between horses, was in tight into the turn and fell back some, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FOREST SOUVENIR pulled between horses chasing the pace, steadied repeatedly from the half mile pole until past the three eighths marker, came out but was blocked off heels into the stretch, angled in and lacked a rally. THIEF RIVER had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked the winner leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch.
