### Footnotes

TRIBAL GAL had good early speed and set the pace off the rail then a bit off the fence, met a bid on the turn, inched away again in the stretch and won clear under urging. COTTON'S POINT stalked between horses then inside on the turn and in the stretch, could not match the winner but edged a rival for the place. SOPHIE'S SECRET close up tracking the winner between horses on the backstretch, bid alongside that rival on the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. BOLLER BOMB went up between horses then stalked outside into the turn, angled in outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch, lugged in a bit in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. GLOBAL WARMING between foes early, chased inside, came out in the stretch and improved position. IT'S AINE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the turn and could not offer the necessary late kick. A LITTLE LUCKIER fell back after the start then moved up between horses to stalk the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. ONLY JOSIE KNOWS settled a bit off the rail, went between horses on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and was not a threat. SWISS BLISS chased four wide then angled in outside a rival and fell back some on the turn, split horses into the stretch and weakened. TRIBAL RAIN came off the rail and went outside a rival on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a factor.
