ALL SQUARED AWAY saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up on the wire. NO SILENT stalked off the rail then angled in on the first turn, came out some on the second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter into the stretch, gained the advantage, inched away past midstretch and held on well but was edged on the line. RANSOM CANYON a step slow to begin, angled in on the first turn and saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit past midstretch and went around a rival late for the show. SEVENTH AVENUE (IRE) pulled three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail, steadied in tight off heels into the stretch, angled in, came out past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. DISTORT THIS had good early speed off the rail, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled into the stretch and until just past midstretch, then weakened. HELLO FRANKIE had speed outside then angled in and stalked alongside the winner, fell back some on the second turn, was between foes into the stretch and also weakened. EMPIRE WAY pulled his way along early and stalked three deep, also fell back some on the second turn and weakened. GENERAL CAUSEWAY allowed to settle inside, saved ground to the stretch and was not a threat.
