Footnotes

FAST EYDIE broke out a bit, raced three deep early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch, angled in nearing midstretch, gained the lead under urging in deep stretch and proved best. MISS OOPS stalked three wide then outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter and was floated out four wide into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, battled outside a sixteenth from home, could not match the winner late but held second. FIFTH COMMANDMENT (IRE) had good early speed and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, drifted out into the stretch, battled between foes at the sixteenth pole and bested the others. ENTABENI chased a bit off the rail then inside, moved up leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. REAL HOUSEWIFE settled off the inside chasing the pace, came out three wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. ROSSI RESERVE had speed inside then stalked along the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened. RACHEL JONES a bit crowded at the start, chased between horses then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. PICTURE PERFECT (IRE) pulled her way between horses on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. INDYCAT had speed between foes to stalk the pace, dropped back inside on the turn and weakened. AFTER LATER chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. MY FRIEND GAIL broke a bit slowly, settled outside then four wide on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the turn and was not a factor.
