**Footnotes**

JACIRO stalked between horses on the backstretch and most of the turn, came out into the stretch, rallied to the front under left handed urging in deep stretch and proved best. DEE DEE'S DINER stalked outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and just got the place. ZAM ZAM had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, took a narrow advantage on the turn, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late and just lost second then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. RADON angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch but weakened late. PLAYGIRL a bit crowded early, angled in and saved ground, moved up some on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPINNING AT DAWN close up stalking the pace inside to the stretch, weakened. HOLLYWOOD HONEY chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. PONCHE DE LEONA chased off the rail, came outside a rival into the stretch and was not a threat. MOYANNA (IRE) dropped back early, settled off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and was outrun.
