Footnotes

ISHMAEL went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away leaving the turn and kicked clear into the stretch and held under left handed urging. PICO PICO stalked the pace inside to the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the land and went willingly to the wire. FOG ALERT was in a good position stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch and outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and bested the others. SIX EIGHTEEN a bit slow into stride, settled along the rail, saved ground throughout and lacked the needed rally. UR TURN DUBAI sped to the early lead, dueled outside the winner until nearing the stretch and weakened. BRADIO STATION allowed to settle outside then three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. FLYING WINGS chased between horses or off the rail, dropped back leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. UNUSUALLY BLESSED settled between horses then off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a threat. AGGRAVATED BATTERY close up stalking the pace outside a rival or a bit off the rail leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch.
