BUSTANAI angled in and settled inside then a bit off the rail, moved up just off the fence leaving the second turn and into the stretch, rallied between horses

under urging in deep stretch and got up late. CASA O chased off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and finished with interest six wide on the wire. CAT BRANDO chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, was in a bit tight nearing the second turn, came out leaving that turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied five wide on the line. GOBBLER'S KNOB settled outside a rival, split horses on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch, angled in some in the drive and rallied between foes late. BRED ROYAL four wide early, chased three deep then off the rail, continued outside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch, took a short lead in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and was outfinished between horses on the line. BATTLE POINT pulled his way along to duel inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch, drifted out then in from the whip in deep stretch and was outfinished. OUTRAGEOUS FORTUNE angled in and raced unhurried outside a rival to the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and found his best stride late. ONE FRENCH KISS three deep early, dueled outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. HIGHEST HONORS between foes early, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LITTLE TRAVIS allowed to settle along the inside, saved ground throughout and did not rally. SONG SINGER between horses early, chased outside a rival, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong. YVETT'S MAAR pulled his way along and angled in on the first turn, came off the rail on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and into the stretch, was kept to some urging past midstretch then was eased late.
