Footnotes

BURNS angled in and chased inside, moved up into the stretch, waited briefly then bid inside to gain a short lead past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. LIL BIT O'FUN pulled early then angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in some in midstretch but finished well. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back between horses in the stretch and was in tight on the wire. MIDNIGHT INTERLUDE stalked outside a rival then between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, was blocked off heels and steadied in midstretch, continued willingly and was edged for the show. SURREY STAR (IRE) stalked off the rail then bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, fought back between horses past midstretch and weakened some late. FORT HASTINGS (IRE) pulled early and chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, was a bit crowded in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick.
