Footnotes

COMMENDABLE, stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep on the turn, took command leaving the bend and drew clear under a mild hand ride. SILVER AXE, wide early, angled in nearing the turn, swung out into the stretch and finished well for second. RONTON settled off the inside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and just got third. TOQUEVILLE, between horses early, went three deep on the turn, drifted out a bit late and just lost the show. MOROCCO, steadied when squeezed after the start, moved up inside, came out leaving the turn, then was in tight off heels late. UNDER SURVEILLANCE sped to the early lead and angled in, dueling inside on the turn but weakened. EGGBERT, dropped back between foes on the backstretch, swung out leaving the turn and lacked the needed response. HERB'S BIRTHDAY, outrun off the rail, angled in nearing the turn, came out in the stretch and did not rally. HAPPY SPORT, close up between horses on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn and weakened. JEKYLL AND HYDE, stalked the pace inside, bid between rivals on the turn but weakened in the drive. COLDWATER CANYON, saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the turn and had little left.
