SWING THE CAT (NZ) sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, opened a commanding advantage on the second turn and held on gamely under some left handed urging. DANCLARE rank between horses early, angled in and chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and finished willingly. AGATA (FR) settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and bested the others. THERMOSTATIC saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SEEKING THE HEART off a bit slowly, settled inside, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. DROUGHT BREAKER steadied slightly in the chute, chased between horses then a bit off the rail, found the fence leaving the backstretch and did not rally. JOHN'S KINDA GIRL saved ground chasing the winner, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. FIVE NICKELS hopped in a bit of a slow start, raced four wide leaving the chute, chased three deep then outside a rival and also weakened.
