Footnotes

DINNER AT JAKE'S broke out and bumped a rival, angled in and stalked inside, came off the rail in deep stretch and rallied between horses late under some urging to get up. IT'S IN THE FRIDGE broke in and bumped a foe, had speed off the rail then angled in and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch, could not hold off the winner but edged a rival for second, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. TAHOE KID bumped at the start, chased three deep then between foes, split rivals three wide into the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. CACH D FISH had speed outside then dueled three deep, battled outside the runner-up leaving the backstretch and on the turn, had that one slip away in the stretch and went between foes late. SEVEN LUCKY J'S steadied when squeezed at the start, chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and had a late bid five wide on the line. WARREN'S HOTROD settled off the pace inside, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MICKEY ROCKS steadied when squeezed at the start, pulled his way between horses and was in tight into the turn, continued three deep and could not offer the necessary response. SUGAR AND SPICE (MEX) settled a bit off the rail without early speed, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. PAMPEROS EDGE broke a bit slowly, also settled just off the inside without early speed, came out into the stretch and was not a factor. MILWAUKEE ROCKET bumped and squeezed at the start, chased outside a rival then off the rail on the turn and did not rally. RACE TO SPACE also bumped and squeezed at the break, chased outside a foe then between rivals on the turn, found the rail in the stretch and weakened. ROGUE RIVER angled in and prompted the pace between horses, stalked off the rail leaving the backstretch and between rivals on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
