Footnotes

INTOTHEWILD had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away into the stretch, kicked clear under urging and proved best. BROADWAY PROMISE prompted the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, continued a bit off the rail in the stretch and held second. SNOWBOUND SAILOR broke slowly, settled inside chasing the pace, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, lugged inward through the drive and bested the rest. SKIPPER'S HONOR settled off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and did not rally. EMINENT HONOR broke in, bobbed then steadied at the start, chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. SENSE OF HONOR dropped back outside on the backstretch, angled in alongside a rival on the turn and was not a threat. ENAMORADO squeezed a bit at the start, went up between horses then pressed the pace three deep to the stretch and weakened.
