### Footnotes

COATCHECK GIRL stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn, took the lead alongside the pacesetter into the stretch and drew off while drifting out under some left handed urging. SUPER SOPHIE pulled a bit early and chased off the rail, came out into the stretch and was clearly second best. LIVING OUR DREAM squeezed at the start, settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and got up for the show. MOSCOW RISING pulled her way to the lead outside a rival early, angled in and set the pace inside, kicked clear, weakened in the final furlong and was edged late for third. CORACAO BEIJO saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CINNAMON DOVE three deep leaving the chute, chased outside a rival and lacked a response in the stretch. SAND BRIDLED broke out and bobbed, angled in and saved ground off the pace and did not rally. RAISE AGAIN also broke out and bobbed, angled in and settled inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
