Footnotes

SUGARINTHEMORNING bumped between foes at the start, stalked between rivals then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out off heels in upper stretch, bid three deep past midstretch, lugged in some despite left handed urging, gained the lead in deep stretch and won clear. CALIFORNIA NECTAR dueled outside a rival, was between horses past midstretch and outfinished the pacesetter for the place. CLUBHOUSE RULES had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened some late but clearly bested the others. DISTANT GLOW squeezed back at the start, settled off the rail, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position. ARTA B TAPPIN broke out onto foes, stalked a bit

off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. TOP STUDENT chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn, found the rail in the stretch and weakened. SEAN S bumped at the start, was between horses early then stalked outside, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. QUEENIE MARINI settled outside then four wide into and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. EZ RACHEL broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. TEDDY'S PROMISE bumped between horses at the start, went up between foes then stalked outside, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. PALAIS DE L'ELYSEE chased between horses or off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and weakened. WARREN'S HANDFULL settled outside then alongside a rival, angled in for the turn and failed to menace.
