COZI ROSIE saved ground chasing the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, bid along the inside, gained the advantage past midstretch and held on gamely under some left handed urging. MALIBU PIER bobbled slightly at the start and had the rider adjust the left iron, angled in and chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip after a left handed crack of the stick in midstretch but finished well. WASTED TEARS sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled outside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly to hold third. HARMONIOUS settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and closed well but was outfinished. GO FORTH NORTH bumped at the start, chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came out into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. TURNING TOP (IRE) bumped at the start, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail chasing the pace, found the fence in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MEDAGLIA D'AMOUR also bumped at the break, angled in after the chute and stalked off the rail to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
