DOUBLE CAT pulled her way along to stalk the pace off the rail, bid outside the leader leaving the second turn, took a short lead nearing midstretch and proved best under good handling. MABEL KENT sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back into and through the stretch along the rail but could not quite match the winner late. SECRET OF MECCA pulled early, saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and bested the rest. MPENZI off a bit slowly, settled off the rail, moved up inside into and on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed late kick. EXTREME DELIGHT allowed to settle and angled in on the first turn, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. LULU'S QUEEN veered in at the start, pulled her way along inside, came out in upper stretch and failed to menace. DADSLITTLEMARIA pulled between horses early, chased outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and weakened. LA JOLLA SHORES was in a good position chasing the leaders three deep, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened. NIGHQUE STAR unhurried off the rail, trailed on the backstretch and second turn and was outrun.
