Footnotes

BALTIC NATIONS chased between horses then angled in a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted a bit in the drive but rallied under some urging to get up late. JUNIPER SPRINGS had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away a bit off the rail on the turn, angled in leaving the bend and held on well but was caught late. ON THE Q TEA saved ground stalking the pace, came out past midstretch and finished well between foes late. WINSOME DAME went up inside to duel for command, was in a bit tight nearing midway on the turn, came out into the stretch and was outfinished. RESONANT a bit slow to begin, chased outside, came five wide into the stretch, was forced out a bit in upper stretch and put in a late bid. PLAYGIRL also off a bit slowly, settled between horses early then angled in and saved ground but lacked the needed rally. MAGNETIC PLACE close up stalking the pace outside on the backstretch, ranged up three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, then drifted in and weakened. ARCH ABILITY broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. AMAPOLA'S WISH also off a bit slowly, went up outside a rival on the backstretch, drifted out on the turn and failed to menace. HERE 'N' SASSY hopped and broke slowly, was pulled up in the early stages but walked off.
