STAKES Pat O'Brien Breeders' Cup H. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which shall accompany the nomination, or by supplementary nomination of \$1,500 each by Sunday, August 8, \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The host association's monies to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided, provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert to the Fund. Weights Monday, August 9. High weights preferred. The starters will be determined at entry time with preference given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or weight assignment (respective of sex and weight for age). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Nominations closed Thursday, August 5, 2004 with 12.

Footnotes

KELA unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, moved up outside on the turn, swept to the front three deep into the stretch and pulled clear under some urging. DOMESTIC DISPUTE stalked outside a rival then off the rail leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and gained the place. PICO CENTRAL (BRZ) had good early speed and dueled inside a rival but a bit off the rail, angled in and fought back on the turn, and weakened in the stretch but held third. HASTY KRIS saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and weakened. TASTE OF PARADISE angled in and dueled outside PICO CENTRAL, put a head in front on the turn, was between horses into the stretch and also weakened.
