Footnotes

POKOMOKE stalked inside then off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a narrow advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. POWEROFVOODOO angled in and settled off the pace inside, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out in the stretch and finished well. RUSHEN HEAT had speed between horses then angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and held third. JUNE MY LOVE four wide early, angled in and dueled outside a rival then between foes on the second turn, also fought back between horses in the drive and was outfinished. TRIBAL FIRE saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed response. FREEDOM SUMMIT between horses early, chased outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. MISS APOLLITA allowed to settle outside a foe chasing the pace and did not rally. ROBADORABLE forced wide on the first turn, angled to the inside on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive. BLUE CORN MOON drifted out on the first turn, angled in and chased just off the inside and was not a threat.
