SIX PACK ABS chased outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch, gained the lead outside the runner-up past the eighth pole and pulled clear under some urging. TRANQUILO stalked outside rivals, bid three deep on the turn, took a short advantage into the stretch, fought back inside the winner in midstretch and held second. DENNYBUCK stalked between horses then off the rail on the turn, came out some in the stretch and bested the rest. FIVE STAR CHARM chased inside then off the rail, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed

rally. BEAU'S BEST BABY settled off the inside chasing the leaders, split rivals on the turn and could not summon the necessary response. COYOTE FAST had good early speed and angled in, dueled outside a rival then between horses on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. HOT GUY bobbed at the start, angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but also weakened in the stretch. RECUERDO PIA (BRZ) was in a good position stalking the pace inside, dropped back some on the turn and had little left for the stretch. SUREFIRE SUCCESS allowed to settle off the pace outside, came a bit wide into the stretch and was not a threat. NORTH AMERICA broke in the air and slowly, settled off the rail, trailed throughout and was outrun. BAND OF THUNDER was pulled up along the inside in the early going and vanned off.
