TELL A KELLY settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, moved up inside on the turn, came out leaving the bend, was fanned four wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up under some urging past midstretch, gained the advantage nearing the sixteenth pole and won clear. INDIAN GRACEY prompted the pace outside a rival, bid alongside that one leaving the turn, took the lead while being floated out some into the stretch, inched away, fought back inside the winner past midstretch, then could not match that one while clearly second best. RACHEL JONES stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, drifted in some in midstretch and edged a rival for third. TIZ THE ROUTE wide early, chased outside then off the rail, angled in leaving the turn, continued on the inside in the stretch and was edged for the show. HEY MARIA sped between foes to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. SKY ANGEL chased off the rail then three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. PACIFIC COAST GIRL between horses early, stalked outside a rival, dropped back between horses on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
