SPANIARD bumped at the start, had good early speed outside a rival then inched away a half mile out, set the pace a bit off the rail, kicked clear on the turn, drifted in some in deep stretch and proved best under left handed urging and a long hold late. STACY'S HOPE hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, settled inside then just off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, angled in again in midstretch then split horses late for the place. S. S. STONE prompted the pace inside then stalked a bit off the rail, drifted in some in the stretch and just held third. LEOTHELION broke in and bumped the winner, pulled between horses to chase the pace, angled in on the turn, came off the rail in the stretch and was outfinished late for a minor award. THE BAT SIGNAL chased between horses then outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. THE WHAMMER stalked between rivals then a bit off the rail and weakened in the stretch. SCORED saved ground off the pace, remained inside on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. DARK AND DEEP wide early, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
