SHRUG stalked the pace inside, came out in the stretch, bid between horses past midstretch, gained a short advantage and held on gamely under urging. LAKERVILLE broke out, bumped a rival then steadied just after the start, settled outside then off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and finished with a rush outside foes. SIROCCO STRIKE pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came out a bit on the turn, swung three deep into the stretch and rallied between horses late. KOAST angled in and stalked outside a rival, bid three wide past midstretch and continued willingly. SILVER SUMMATION stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into the stretch, took the lead, inched away in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and was outfinished. BENCH POINTS between horses early, chased outside a rival, drifted wide on the turn, angled back in nearing the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ROYAL PRODUCTION bumped at the start, sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the rail, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
