Footnotes

WINDOW B stalked the pace wide on the backstretch, bid three deep on the turn, gained the lead and kicked clear under urging and was under a strong hand ride to the wire. BULLY'S NORTH sent between horses early, chased off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn, split rivals in upper stretch and again late for second. SWIFT TERMS settled a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and six wide into the stretch and gained the show late. WILD COWBOY chased wide on the backstretch, moved up four wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lost third late. RAISING THE BANNER sent between horses early, continued off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. TOP HIT also sent between horses early,

continued off the rail on the turn and weakened. ROBALEUR a bit crowded at the start, angled in on the backstretch, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and had no late response. TAKEHIMTOTHELIMIT went up four wide on the backstretch to duel for the lead, battled outside a rival on the turn and inside the winner into the stretch and weakened. GOLDEN AFFECT broke awkwardly, was outrun off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace. FIRE FIGHTER had good early speed and dueled between horses on the backstretch, angled in and battled on the turn but had little left for the stretch. TRUE DELIGHT hustled along to vie for command along the inside, dropped back on the turn and also had little left for the stretch. FLYING BADGER dueled between horses on the backstretch, was shuffled between horses while weakening on the turn and gave way.
