SINGLETARY had speed three deep early then outside a rival into the first turn, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, kicked clear on the second turn and held gamely under urging. DEVIOUS BOY (GB) off a bit slowly, chased off the rail, angled in some on the second turn, split rivals into the stretch and closed gamely. SENOR SWINGER unhurried outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out a bit in upper stretch, split horses in midstretch and rallied along the rail. FAIRLY RANSOM saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. SWEET RETURN (GB) pulled his way between horses early then stalked outside a rival, continued between horses past midstretch and weakened. STANLEY PARK saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MINISTERS WILD CAT pulled his way up inside to press the early pace, stalked the winner a bit off the rail on the backstretch, found the fence again on the second turn, weakened in the stretch and was not urged in the final furlong.
