Footnotes

AMBER TWILIGHT had speed between horses then set the pace a bit off the rail, kicked away on the backstretch, drifted out in midstretch despite right handed urging, then drifted in late and held. MIST OF THE EMPIRE saved ground off the pace, inched forward leaving the backstretch, moved up inside on the second turn, came out in the stretch, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. WEB CASTER three deep into the first turn, angled in and chased a bit off the rail, continued outside the runner-up into the stretch and held third. TELL NO TALES chased outside, advanced four wide leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. LA BELLA stumbled at the start, lagged back inside, came out into the stretch and improved position. I MISS YOU sent inside early, stalked a bit off the rail, was between horses on the second turn and weakened. ENTICE ME chased outside then between horses leaving the backstretch, dropped back outside on the second turn and weakened. DANCIN DOLL four wide into the first turn, chased outside, also dropped back on the second turn, angled in and also weakened. FUHRMIDABLE between horses early, settled a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn and did not rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled the winner drifting out did not alter the original order of finish.
