SARAH GOT EVEN saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn, swung out into the stretch, collared the pacesetter nearing the sixteenth pole, inched away and held under urging. STANFORD DOLLY settled off the pace inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, came out for room in deep stretch and finished well. SAINT CINDY settled between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and gained the show. RED MOON CAT three deep into the first turn, settled outside a rival then off the rail, split horses into the stretch and was outfinished for third. REALLY ELEGANT sped to the early lead, pulled a bit and opened a clear advantage, remained clear in midstretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. MUSICAL GRACE chased off the rail then inside came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. AKEELA a bit washy at the gate, was between horses early, then chased outside a rival or off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. TRAPPER'S REWARD four wide early, chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, drifted in and weakened. ROULETTE IT ROLL also four wide early, angled in outside a rival then stalked off the rail, dropped back between foes on
