Footnotes

ACENDA pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, bid along the rail on the second turn, took a short lead, dueled, kicked clear a bit off the fence in the stretch and held under urging. DIME PIECE three wide into the first turn, angled in and chased inside, cut the corner into the stretch, came out in deep stretch and edged a rival for the place. GHOST OF A CHANCE bobbled slightly, broke out and was forced out some at the start, angled in and chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn, split horses in midstretch and was edged for second. URANIA chased a bit off the rail then came out on the second turn, was three wide leaving that turn and into the stretch, continued four wide in midstretch and lacked a response in the final furlong. CHAPEL CHICK allowed to settle off the pace inside, came out around a rival leaving the second turn and lacked the needed rally. SPIN THE BLUES squeezed at the start, settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and improved position but was not a threat. DRESS THE PART stalked three deep then outside the winner, bid three deep into the second turn, dueled alongside the winner on that bend and into the stretch, dropped back between foes in midstretch and weakened. POGONIP pulled between foes then chased a bit off the rail, swung three wide into the stretch and also weakened. MAGIC FIRE angled in on the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back some on the second turn and lacked a further response. CUPID'S BLING broke outward, pulled her way to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, drifted out into and on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and gave way.
