Footnotes

LOVE ALL THE WAY unhurried off the rail early, moved up outside on the turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to be along in time. THE MORRIS MONROE stalked the pace a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out leaving the bend and into the stretch and finished willingly for second. ROCKY BAR quickly sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled inside on the turn, fought back through the stretch and also continued willingly to the end. PEACH FLAT stalked the early pace off the rail, bid outside the leader and dueled on the turn, took a short lead nearing the stretch but was outfinished. IMPRESSIVE GRADES chased between horses on the backstretch and toward the inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. MOROCCO settled off the pace without early speed, angled in on the backstretch, went around a rival leaving the turn, angled to the rail, steadied off heels past midstretch and was blocked behind rivals the final sixteenth. RAPIDOUGH chased three deep between horses on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed rally. MATEKA (FR) was in a good position chasing the pace four wide on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. MARTEL went up inside to track the leader on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and also weakened.
