BIKER'S SIS chased outside on the backstretch, moved up boldly four wide then three deep on the turn to take command into the stretch and drew clear under a brisk hand ride. CHIC DOMESTIQUE settled outside on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the turn and into the stretch and gained the place late. LARKWOOD off a bit awkwardly, went up inside leaving the backstretch, was shuffled a bit along the rail leaving the turn, came out nearing the stretch but steadied off heels into the stretch, came out again and just got the show. ROSIE MY BUDDIE dueled three deep then outside a rival into the turn, angled in leaving the bend and weakened in the stretch. GABBY DANCER wide early, stalked outside on the backstretch and four wide into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BLONDE AMBITION was in a good position chasing between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. CULLEY had speed between horses to press the early pace, stalked outside a rival into and on the turn and weakened. MY KIMBERLEE ANNE chased a bit off the rail, waited a bit midway on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. CHILEAN STORM

saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. HARD TO CALL had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back leaving the turn and had little left. WALTZ IN HALF TIME off a bit slowly, settled off the rail and was always outrun. TENMA hopped in a bit of an awkward start and had the rider lose the irons at the start, pulled his way along off the rail, drifted out into the stretch and was eased up late.
