Footnotes

DISTURBINGTHEPEACE went up inside to duel for command, put a head in front nearing the turn, inched away into the stretch and won clear under urging. RUSHIN' TO ALTAR settled outside on the backstretch, moved up between horses on the turn and along the inside into the stretch and was clearly second best. FULL MOON MADNESS forced the early pace between horses then dropped back into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and edged foes late for third. TOUGH GAME off a bit awkwardly, stalked off the rail then went up five wide leaving the backstretch, prompted the pace three deep on the turn and weakened in the stretch. DITCH DIGGER (ARG) pressed the early pace four wide then stalked outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. KELA allowed to settle off the rail then between horses, angled in on the turn and lacked the needed rally. BLUESTHESTANDARD had good early speed and dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn but weakened in the stretch. SEA TO SEE off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. DANTHEBLUEGRASSMAN wide early, chased outside or off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and failed to menace. DEBONAIR JOE was in a good position stalking the pace off the rail on the backstretch and turn, weakened.
